Editors Note:

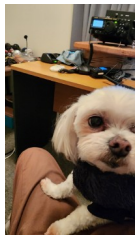

1. Supplying a stamped addressed envelope or mailing package if large numbers are expected. Preferred stamps are KIWI stamps.

Postage charges and size and weight limits are available from Post shops or on the NZPO website.

2. Via your local Club-as above. Cards for all members on a list supplied by the relevant club are posted in bulk for distribution by the club.

If you not wish to receive cards we would appreciate advice to this effect.

Unclaimed cards will be held for 6 months before being disposed off.

REG Equipment Library : For some time now REG have had an equipment library, made up of items generously donated by our members and others outside the club. This is made up of a handheld UHF/VHF FM dual-bander, dual band FM mobile, various power supplies and a range of test equipment. We have a book as the central

equipment register, where members can book out equipment items for up to 3 months at a time.

This can be for newbies, once they have their callsign, to help them try some gear and then decide what they would like to purchase. We don't have any HF rigs at present, so if you have one gathering dust, and would like to donate them, that would be fantastic. Our club 'Equipment Librarian' is Kevin ZL2TKH (021-441999) who can answer any questions, and book out equipment.

NZART Memorial Contest:

I participated in this contest over the weekend of July 4/5th

The NZART Memorial Contest has been held every year since 1946 to commemorate those New Zealand amateur radio operators who lost their lives in World War 2.

The contest is held every year on the Saturday and Sunday of the first weekend of July.

1. When

Saturday & Sunday of the first weekend in July each year

0800 – 1100 UTC (2000 – 2300 NZST)

Three one-hour operating periods each evening.

2. Band

80m only – A station may be contacted twice during each operating period – once on SSB and once on CW, provided that contacts are not consecutive.

Suggested Frequencies

●CW 3520-3550 kHz

●SSB 3610-3660 kHz

Personally I participated over the whole weekend. I managed 122 contacts with a multiplier list of 7. I operated with the callsign ZM2CJ. I was in a new category set up this year. New Ham less than 36 months since license. Low power category of 100w.

I certainly found previous involvement in the Jock White fieldays had honed my skills and operating procedures and systems well.

I don't think I'll come 1st as in some ways using a Unique callsign was a slight disadvantage but all in all it was a lot of fun and challenging.

Perhaps we should organise a club team for next year.
